## Practice 5: Silent letters

A silent letter is the one we write but do not pronounce. There aren't any general rules or hints on how to recognize a silent consonant. In most cases, we have to learn the pronunciation of the word together with its meaning.

However, let's see which letters can become silent and try to find some common patterns.

Silent B
$\mathrm{m}+\mathrm{b}=/ \mathrm{m} /$
If the word ends in $\mathbf{m b}, \mathrm{b}$ is silent. It will also be silent in derived words.
b+t = /t/
Sometimes when the word contains $\mathbf{b t}, \mathrm{b}$ is silent.
bomb, climb, comb, lamb, thumb, plumb, climber, plumber
debt, doubt, subtle

Silent T
In some words the letter $\mathbf{t}$ is silent. In some originally French words, there is a silent $\mathbf{t}$ at the end.
castle, chestnut, Christmas, fasten, listen, mortgage, often
ballet, buffet, valet, debut

Silent H
heir, honour, hour, ghost, rhythm
what, when, where, while, white, why

Silent K
$\mathrm{k}+\mathrm{n}=/ \mathrm{n} /$
If the word begins with $\mathbf{k n}, \mathrm{k}$ is usually not pronounced.
knee, knew, knife, knight, knit, knock, know

Silent W
w+r=/r/
If the word begins with wr, $\mathbf{w}$ is silent. But that's not the only case where it is silent.
wrap, wrist, wrinkle, wreck, write
answer, towards, two
whole, who, whom, whose

Silent G
$\mathrm{g}+\mathrm{n}=/ \mathrm{n} /$
If the word ends in $\mathbf{g n}$, g is often silent.
align, campaign, design, foreign, reign, sign

Silent N
$\mathrm{m}+\mathrm{n}=/ \mathrm{m} /$
There are some words with $\mathbf{m n}$ combination where n is not pronounced.
autumn, column, condemn, damn, hymn, solemn

Silent L
I $+\mathrm{m}=/ \mathrm{m} /$
Sometimes I is not pronounced when it is combined with m . But there are more words where it is silent.
balm, calm, palm, almond, salmon
calf, half, chalk, walk, could, should, would, colonel
